The internal belief you have in Jesus should produce external change in you

- ■V.14-16
- Can faith without works save you?
- ■V.17-19
- Faith, if it has no works, is dead
- How are you going to show that your faith is alive?
- You believe, good for you, the demons also believe.

 $\bigotimes \mathsf{Real}$ faith goes beyond our belief and into our behaviors

- •V.20-24
- Abraham didn't just believe, he acted
- People are justified by works and not by faith alone
- ♦ Justified
- = to be made right
- = to prove that something is right

♦ James: Talking about Christian Living - James 2:24
